IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PLAYER LICENCE

- UK residents must have a British Foosball Association (BFA) Class A Player Licence to enter ITSF events (Open, Women's Over 50, Under 19, Mixed).
- A Class A or B licence is required to enter Masters, Semi-Pro and Amateur events.
- A Class C/no licence is required to enter the Monster DYPs.
- If you need a licence or need to upgrade your existing licence, please contact your club leader, or the BFA contact@britfoos.com.
- Players residing outside of the UK must have an ITSF licence issued by their national federation.

CAPACITY LIMIT

This tournament will be run on 10x ITSF Tornado tables. To ensure the smooth running of this tournament each event is limited by capacity.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

- Register for the tournament online in Coral (app.tablesoccer.org)
- Purchase your event tickets online at www.londontablefootball.com or in Coral
- Once you have purchased your event tickets your place in the event is secured
- There is no registration or organisation fee for this tournament.

PRIZE FUND

- This tournament has a guaranteed prize fund of £2,000
- The prize fund allocated to each event is calculated proportionate to the revenue per event

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

EVENT EXCLUSIVITY

- Seniors can choose Over 50 events or Classic Doubles or Mixed Doubles
- Mixed Doubles is exclusive with Classic Doubles
- Masters Doubles is exclusive with Semi-Pro Doubles
- Open Doubles is exclusive with Women's Doubles
- Amateur Singles is exclusive with Semi-Pro Singles

EVENT ELIGIBILITY

- Over 50 events: Only players aged 50 or over
- Under 19 events: Only players aged under 19
- Semi-Pro events: Only players rated Semi-Pro, Amateur, Beginner or unrated
- Amateur events: Only players rated Amateur, Beginner or unrated
- All international non-UK resident players are rated Pro and are not eligible for Semi-Pro or Amateur events.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

SEEDING

- ITSF events will be seeded according to ITSF ranking
- Seeds are protected for the first round of qualification in ITSF events

MISCELLANEOUS

- All matches must be played with Tornado balls. Balls (and wraps) can be purchased at the tournament.
- ITSF rules will be applied including ITSF overtime rules for all ITSF events.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter event formats to ensure the smooth running of the tournament.
- Standard ITSF recall procedure will be in effect for all matches.
- If fewer than 4 players/teams register for an event it will be cancelled.
